

Breast Cancer Care at AKUH

Breast cancer remains one of the most pressing health challenges for women in Pakistan. While the disease can be life-threatening, early detection and timely treatment greatly increase the chances of recovery. Unfortunately, many women delay seeking help because of financial and social barriers, putting their health at greater risk.

At the Aga Khan University Hospital, women receive comprehensive breast cancer services under one roof — from diagnosis and surgery to chemotherapy, radiation therapy, and long-term follow-up. A dedicated team of oncologists, surgeons, radiologists, and nurses work together to provide world-class treatment with empathy and respect.

For many families, such advanced treatment would be out of reach without donor support. Through the Patient Welfare Programme (PWP) and Zakat and donations through PBS for AKUH, women who once thought they had no options are now able to undergo critical procedures and continue their lives with restored strength and renewed confidence.

At AKUH, breast cancer treatment goes beyond fighting a disease — it is about empowering women, rebuilding families, and creating the possibility of a healthier tomorrow.



Sana Survives Breast Cancer

Sana, a devoted mother of young children from Hyderabad, began experiencing recurring pain in her breast. At first, she sought treatment locally and even underwent surgery, but the pain soon returned, leaving her anxious and uncertain about the future.

Her family then turned to AKUH, where a biopsy confirmed her greatest fear: Sana was suffering from stage 3 breast cancer. Dr Sana Zeeshan explained that to save her life, her breast would need to be removed.

Over the course of a year, Sana bravely underwent surgery, followed by radiation and chemotherapy. It was an exhausting and

emotional journey — made even harder by the financial strain, as her husband, a small factory worker, could not afford the cost of advanced treatment.

Thanks to PWP at AKUH, supported by Zakat and donations through PBS for AKUH, Sana received the full course of life-saving care. Slowly, she regained her strength and her will to fight for her children's future.

Today, Sana is healthy and able to return to her role as a mother with renewed hope and her family continues to offer heartfelt prayers for the donors whose generosity gave them strength in their darkest time.

Irfan longed for a normal, active life, but his heart condition made even simple tasks a struggle. With a leaking valve, he experienced shortness of breath, a racing heartbeat and fluid in his lungs that left him unable to manage daily activities.

He visited the Aga Khan University Hospital, where he was treated by Dr Shahid Sami, who advised urgent valve replacement surgery. The cost was beyond his family's means, but support through PBS for AKUH from generous donors made his treatment possible.

The surgery changed everything. Within just ten days, Irfan regained his strength — climbing stairs, walking without exhaustion and breathing freely once more. He could once again enjoy everyday moments with his family, free from the limitations of his illness.

Today, Irfan lives with renewed energy and hope. For Irfan and his family, every heartbeat is a gift — a reminder of the generosity of donors who gave him not only a healthier heart, but also the chance for a brighter tomorrow.
