Impact of your Generosity in 2025

- ▶ Laboratory services received the largest support, enabling **159,694** patient visits and disbursing **PKR 322** million.
- ▶ **626** paediatric in-patient visits supported with **PKR 94.5** million disbursed for treatment of vulnerable children.
- ▶ **703** adult oncology in-patient visits supported, disbursing **PKR 73.5** million for critical cancer treatment.
- ▶ Paediatric oncology treatment provided to **383** children, disbursing **PKR 32.9** million.
- ▶ **286** orthopaedic and ENT surgeries supported with **PKR 153** million for essential surgical care and quality of life.
- ▶ **181** expectant mothers supported, disbursing **PKR 24.4** million for childbirth and maternal health.
- ▶ **300** internal medicine in-patient visits supported with **PKR 81.5** million for complex lifesaving care.



Hope in the Face of Cancer: Muhammad's Story

Muhammad Farooque was just 18 when he was diagnosed with stage-two osteosarcoma, a rare and aggressive bone cancer.

He began chemotherapy at a local hospital, but instead of improving, his condition worsened. His arm swelled to twice its size, and doctors warned that the cancer was spreading. His family was told that amputation of his arm might be the only option. With hope fading, they turned to AKUH.

At AKUH, Muhammad was reassessed and supported through PBS for AKUH. The medical team assured his parents that every effort would be made to save his arm. After careful planning,

Muhammad underwent a complex surgery led by the AKUH team of experts, followed by multiple rounds of chemotherapy.

The treatment continued for one year. Muhammad was left weak and confined to a wheelchair for a time, but gradually, his strength returned. A year later, Muhammad is walking, healing, and looking forward to the future — with his arm saved and his life restored. For his family, who once feared losing his arm and his life, the financial support from PBS for AKUH for multiple surgeries and chemotherapies made this recovery possible and gave them a reason to look to a brighter future.



Caring For Patients Beyond Treatment

Palliative care focuses on improving the quality of life for patients with serious, life-limiting illnesses by relieving pain and addressing emotional and psychosocial needs. In Pakistan, access to such care remains extremely limited, leaving many patients and families to cope with unnecessary suffering due to low awareness, few trained specialists, and restricted services.

At AKUH, palliative care is delivered through a multidisciplinary model that supports patients and families across inpatient, outpatient, and home-based settings. The service emphasises dignity, comfort, and holistic care alongside medical treatment, ensuring compassionate support at every stage of illness.

Besides expert cancer care, AKUH remains committed to extending compassionate palliative care, placing dignity, comfort, and quality of life at the heart of patient support for those facing serious illness.

Your Zakat and donations enable deserving patients with critical health conditions, such as cancer, to benefit from palliative care services at AKUH. These contributions help extend compassionate, patient-centred support to those who need it most, reducing suffering and improving quality of life for patients and their families.

In 2025, PBS for AKUH provided oncology palliative support to **21** patients battling cancer, disbursing **PKR 4.38** million.
