


Dear PBS Supporters,

We are deeply grateful for the unwavering support we received, which enabled us to continue making a significant difference in the lives of our patients. Thank you for your continued generosity.










Updates on our Flagship Programmes

PBS Zakat Laboratory Programme

AKUH manages an extensive patient access programme, with 248 laboratory units out of the 300+ in Pakistan offering welfare. To further support zakat mustahiq patients access quality diagnostics, PBS for AKUH launched a zakat programme at AKUH laboratories in late 2021.

This programme started at two laboratory units in Karachi, and today, has expanded to 119 units across the country. The zakat support at these labs has been made possible thanks to our generous donors.




Hepatitis - C Elimination Programme

The Hepatitis-C elimination programme was initiated in 2021 by The Aga Khan University Hospital (AKUH) in collaboration with PBS for AKUH and our corporate donors. The programme provides screening, diagnosis, treatment and post-treatment care to diagnosed patients.

Thanks to our donors, the cost of treatment for needy patients has reduced by 75%.

Recently, PBS signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Oil and Gas Development Company Ltd. (OGDCL) to help us bring our Hepatitis-C medical camps to far flung regions in Sindh and Balochistan.

Since the Hepatitis-C programme's inception, we have screened over 89,000 people and over 3,000 have completed treatment.

Pakistan State Oil: Helping Children Born with Congenital Heart Disease



Pakistan State Oil (PSO) and PBS for AKUH have signed an MoU to support the treatment of 20 children suffering from Congenital Heart Disease (CHD).

Under the agreement, PSO will bear all costs of treatment for these children. During the signing ceremony, Mr. Babar Chaudhary, Chairman PSO CSR Trust, presented a cheque for this cause to Mr. Abdul Qadir Memon, President PBS. The ceremony was attended by senior officials from both organisations.

Novartis Pakistan: Supporting Treatment of Cancer Patients



The Aga Khan University Hospital (AKUH) and the Patients' Behbud Society (PBS) for AKUH have signed an MoU with Novartis Pakistan to provide access to quality treatment to financially disadvantaged cancer patients.

Under this MOU, Novartis will provide free-of-cost medicine to AKUH, covering partial treatment costs while PBS will cover the remaining cost of treatment. The MoU signing ceremony was attended by Mr. Arif Tahir, CEO of Novartis Pakistan, Dr. Farhat Abbas, T.I, S.I, CEO of AKUH, and Mr. Abdul Qadir Memon, President of PBS.

Speaking on the occasion, PBS President Mr. Abdul Qadir Memon stated, "It is indeed heartening to see our partners like Novartis Pakistan coming forward to help mustahiq patients by donating expensive cancer remedies. The more zakat and sadaqat we collect, the greater we can serve such needy patients, with ever more barakaat to the givers of this charity."

Dr. Farhat Abbas, T.I, S.I, CEO of AKUH, was keen to comment on this momentous collaboration, "AKUH endeavours to provide access to our health care services for needy patients who may not, on account of financial constraints, be able to afford our regular Hospital charges. Patients who receive financial support receive the same level of care as all other patients. Last year alone we spent more than PKR 5.8 billion on welfare programmes. Our oncologists and other experts aim to provide the best possible treatment to patients and we plan to increase our capacity to treat more patients."


