



The Patients' Behbud Society for Aga Khan University Hospital (PBS), formed in 2001, is an independent society with the primary responsibility of collecting and disbursing zakat to the many *mustehiq* patients that seek quality healthcare at the Hospital but cannot afford the cost of care. Since inception, PBS has helped over **27,000 patients** access treatment for a range of illnesses, including life-threatening diseases, by disbursing **Rs 819 million** worth of zakat.


